1 APPRAISALS



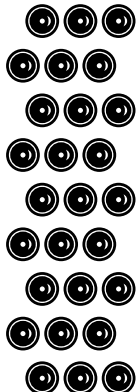

2 INVENTORIES



Inventories are drawn up by our experts, there and then. Following each inventory, a written document is addressed to the owner.

- in an inheritance context
- in the view to put your cellar or wines up for sale

3 VALUATIONS & EXPERT ADVICE



If you are considering an auction, our experts – on approval of the appraisals and inventories – will then proceed to in-depth valuations and inspections of each bottle in your cellar, followed by a detailed proposal and an adapted marketing plan. We advise you on the most suitable selling method for your wines – Room auction, Wine o'clock online auction, private sale, etc. – and we agree together on the best date for the auction.

4 PUTTING YOUR CELLAR OR WINES TO AUCTION



Ahead of the sale, we set up a consignment agreement, listing in detail the wines that you have chosen to deposit with Baghera/wines. This agreement also includes the terms and conditions of sale agreed on together (reserve price of your wines, commission rate, insurance, terms of payment, etc.).



Upon request, we may assist you in the handling of the wines from your cellar and the shipping of the wines to our warehouses in Geneva before the sale, where the bottles will be photographed, catalogued and stored.



Baghera/wines' team works alongside you throughout the entire sale's process to allow your bottles to reach the highest price at the time of sale.

5 PAYMENT



You will receive payment for sold bottles 35 days from the day of the auction.
