BACK TO WINE!

While summer gets to an end here in Europe – a summer season with its share of ups and downs in the vineyard, starting with extreme heat and hail followed by favorable night-time freshness and good rainfalls – impassioned people of the wine look towards the future harvest season. At the end of this month of August, while Donald Trump rises his (comical) wine tax threats to France, the European vineyard and its devoted army of people are getting prepared for the decisive time of the year when all the hard and passionate work in nurturing the vineyard will finally materialize in the noble substance; Wine.

Just like the ideal perpetual renewal of a vine plant season after season, consistency and surprises will be the hallmarks of Baghera's autumn Wine o'clocks, starting with "Back to Wine", a tremendous ensemble of great Swiss and French private wine collections of fine Burgundy and Bordeaux wines.

Patiently gathered by a private Swiss collector, I am thrilled to highlight a rare collection of top-notch Burgundy wines most acquired directly from the Domaines or through their Swiss importer (Mommessin, Dugat-Py, Fourrier, Damoy, Bernstein, Vougeraie, Clos de Tart, Faiveley ...) from the stunning 2005 vintage along with a rarely seen ensemble of +200 bottles and magnums of Domaine Ponsot wines from 2005 to 2015. Amongst many highlights, Ponsot wine lovers will be offered Chambertin, Morey St-Denis, Griotte-Chambertin, Chapelle-Chambertin, Clos de la Roche and Clos St Denis (including the extremely scarce Cuyée du Centenaire).

This "Back to Wine" auction will also offer a rare collection of Domaine Emmanuel Rouget wines coming from a private French collector - including a 13 vintages vertical of Cros-Parantoux, from 1994 to 2011 -, some mature and young Romanée-Conti wines (bottles and assortment case), Roumier and Mugnier's Amoureuses, some great crus classés from Bordeaux (Haut-Brion, Margaux, Mission, Talbot, Gruaud-Larose, Lynch-Bages) along with some desirable Rhône (Bonneau, cuyée des Célestins) from private swiss collections.

"Back to Wine" Wine o'clock will start at 2 pm precisely on Tuesday 10th of September (Swiss time!). Be on time, it will go fast and us Swiss don't mess with time!




HOW TO BID







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CONDITIONS OF SALE

CONDITIONS OF SALE

These conditions of sale govern the contractual relations between Baghera/wines Auction & Trading SA ("Baghera/wines"), the seller whose details are indicated in the Sales Commission document ("Seller"), any participant in the auction or traded or over-the-counter, as well as any bidder and the highest bidder, excluding contractual relations between Baghera/wines and the Seller.

In case of conflict between these conditions of purchase and the terms and conditions of sale, the general terms and conditions of sale shall prevail. These purchase conditions can be modified at any time, in writing or orally during the sale. By participating in any capacity whatsoever in an auction or a private sale organized at Baghera/wines' discretion, you agree to be bound by these conditions. You should therefore read them carefully before doing so.

1. BUYER

Baghera/wines organises only online sales called 'Wine o'Clock'. These sales are processed automatically.

2. AUCTION PROCEDURE

The first customer to click at any bid step (the "Buyer") stops the sale of the concerned lot and wins the bid on the lot of items (the "lot").

3. TRANSFER OF RISK AND PROPERTY

Once awarded to the Buyer, the risks and ownership of the lot(s) pass to the Buyer.

4. ABSENTEE BIDDING

Baghera/wines can place bids on customers' instruction, if you are unable to attend the auction in person, Baghera/wines and its employees or agents cannot be held responsible for failure in the transmission of these instructions during the auction.

In the case where two identical bidding instructions match the highest bidding, the lot will be awarded to the first bidder. Baghera/wines reserves the right in its sole discretion, to refuse bids from a buyer's instructions in case the information and documents submitted as proof of identity, i.e. the identity of the beneficial owner, should prove to be false, incomplete, ambiguous or inadequate.

5. TERMS OF AUCTION

The bid steps decrease from high to low estimate of the lot. All lots have 10 bid steps lasting for 3 seconds.. The first bidder to click at any step stops the sale of the concerned lot and wins the lot. There is no possibility to outbid this lot. If no one bids on the lot and once the 10 seconds of the last step are passed the sale of the lot ends. Then the sale of the next lot begins. 6. ESTIMATE

Definition: "counterfeit" means a wine that in Baghera/wines' reasonable opinion is an imitation created to deceive as to producer and vintage, where the correct description of the producer and vintage is not reflected by the description in the catalogue. The Guarantee is provided for a period of fourteen (14) days from the date of the auction, for the sole benefit of the original Buyer and may not be transferred to any third party. In order to claim under this Guarantee, the Buyer must:

(i) notify within 14 days Baghera/wines in writing of the reasons for believing the wine to be counterfeit. The buyer must specify the lot number and date of the sale at which it was purchased:

and (ii) return the lot to Baghera/wines in the same condition as at the date of sale to the Buyer and be able to transfer property title to the lot, free from any third party claims arising after the date of the sale.

Baghera/wines has discretion to renounce to any of the above elements. In the course of these disclosures, personal data collected in the European Economic Area may be disclosed to countries outside the European Economic Area. Although such countries may not have legislation that protects a client's personal information, Baghera/wines shall take reasonable steps to keep such information secure and in accordance with European data protection principles

By agreeing to these Conditions of Business, the client is agreeing to such disclosure.

25. MISCELLANEOUS

(a) Taxes. If any taxes or rates are applicable to any amount paid by the Buyer, the latter is solely responsible for their payment at the rate and on the date required by the competent administration. (b) Severability provisions. If any provision of this agreement should be judged by a court to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, this provision may be waived and the rest of the Agreement will continue to be valid and enforceable. (c) Personal information. Without your express prior refusal, we will be allowed to keep your personal information and may use it to inform you of our upcoming sales, services and events. (d) Prohibition of Assignment. The Buyer may not assign any benefit and/or obligation under this agreement with Baghera/wines and/or the Seller without our prior written permission. (e) Applicable law and jurisdiction. All contractual relations between the Purchaser, the Seller and Baghera/wines are subject exclusively to Swiss domestic law, to the exclusion of the rules on the conflict of laws (LDIP).
